The DHHS directives for visiting arrangements to our home, remain the same (2nd January 2021). Unless otherwise arranged due to specific circumstances, Visitors are restricted for each Resident, to 1 person for a maximum of 2 hours per day.

We continue to screen visitors in accordance with DHHS directives. The screening process includes checking visitors have not been to exposure sites during specific time frames.

The list of exposure sites is often updated on a daily basis and recently several times in a day.

We strongly encourage visitors to check the DHHS website for the current list of exposure sites, before travelling to visit us. To avoid any doubt, please call our admin team and ask for the current details.

We are hopeful that visiting restrictions will ease soon.

We continue to encourage all visitors book times to visit residents by contacting reception between 9:00am – 3:00pm to schedule a time. Visiting times 10:00am to 2:30pm, 7 days a week.

We will continue to participate in asymptomatic COVID screening and sincerely thank our workforce that have volunteered to undertake this screening on previous occasions.

To our families, friends, and supporters, thank you for your continued support and encouragement to date. We are very sorry to be imposing these restrictions once again, however, do so in accordance with DHHS guidance and importantly, in support of protecting the safety of Residents and our staff.
