Understanding Our Fees and Charges – Residential Aged Care

As of 1 January 2026

Overview

Residential aged care fees are comprised of two main parts: Daily Care Fees and Accommodation Payments for permanent residents. Residents who enter Moyola Lodge for residential respite will pay the Basic Daily Care Fee only.

What Changed to Aged Care Fees in 2026?

From 1 November 2025, the former Means Tested Care Fee was stopped for new residents and replaced with two separate means-tested contributions: the Non-Clinical Care Contribution (NCCC) and the Hotelling Supplement Contribution (HSC).

Daily Care Fees

The Basic Daily Care Fee contributes to everyday living and care costs including meals, cleaning, laundry, personal care, and general living services. The fee is set at 85% of the single basic age pension.

Current Basic Daily Care Fee: \$65.55 per day (indexed September 2025)

Means-Tested Resident Contributions

Services Australia may assess residents to contribute toward non-clinical personal care and everyday living services through the Non-Clinical Care Contribution (NCCC) and Hotelling Supplement Contribution (HSC). Caps apply to the NCCC.

Accommodation Payments

Accommodation costs are based on income and assets and may be paid as a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), or a combination of both. Daily Accommodation Contribution (DAC), Refundable Accommodation Contribution (RAC), or a combination of both.

Accommodation Prices (MPIR 7.65%)

Standard Room: RAD \$395,000 | DAP up to \$82.78 per day

Deluxe Room: RAD \$405,000 | DAP up to \$85.13 per day
